Eg.  $S \rightarrow NP VP$

(Chapter 5: limitations on phrase-structure rules ← looks like PSR not strong enough as a theory)

(Chapter 7: transformations)

Consider

It must have been being eaten ←

problem: association jumping over things. hard to capture with PSR. Lots of discontinuity in English. Fix: affix hopping

Chomsky: rule ordering simplifies things so it's good.
