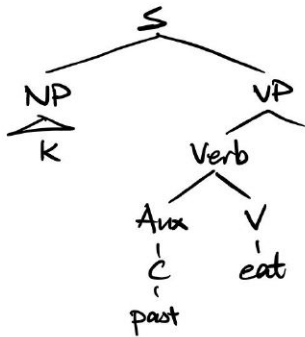

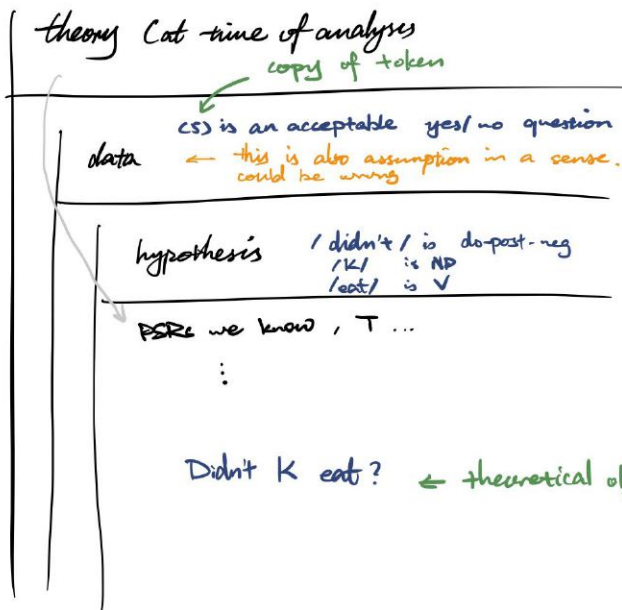
(5) Dint K eat?

- (to) → do + past + n't K eat
- MP → didn't K eat ?

Logical Structure (more)

- ?? ... um

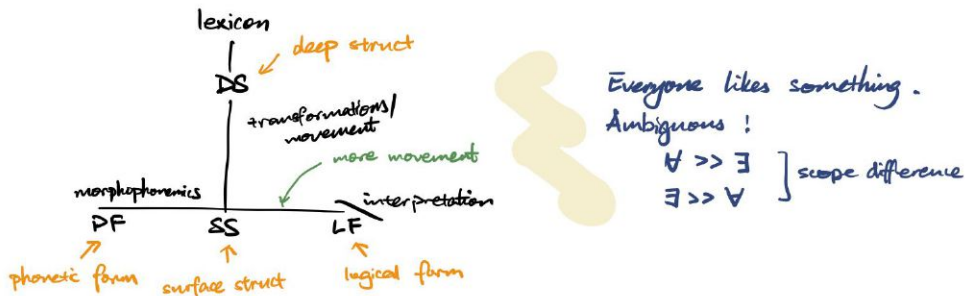
Paper: locative inversion in English
